### EBSCO

EBSCO is the main source to use when looking for articles, including databases like PsycInfo (Psychology), Medline (medicine, including psychiatry and addictions), and ERIC (education).

### Finding Articles With EBSCO

Once you've logged in, get started searching by selecting Psychology Databases. On the next page, click in the Select/deselect all box and then click on the yellow Continue button. This should take you to a page with many options for searching (e.g., by keyword, subject, title, or author).

Near the upper left corner is a line that says adlermn has a suggested style for viewing this library (use it). Click on use it and enter your search terms in the lower right search box, labelled search this library. In your search results, the display will show Library of Congress call numbers. ### **Accessing Journal Content**

From the main page, type art therapy in the search box in the middle of the page and click the enter key. Once you have received search results, on the left-hand side of the page, look for Refine your search. Click the radio button under that link, which is labeled Only show content I have full access to. You should then receive results only to articles you can access in full text. You'll also see a tab labeled Journals, which you can click on to go directly to the two journals to which we subscribe.
